
CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

Positioning BGST to Better Serve Marketplace Christians

Since 2018, BGST has been on a journey of transformation, beginning with our administrative systems and governance, and most recently with the review and enhancement of our postgraduate programmes.





Governance and Administration

We have focussed, in the last three years, on upgrading our financial, human resource, and technological systems. We thank God that this has not only streamlined our operations but also strengthened our governance, evidenced by BGST receiving the Charity Transparency Award in November 2022. In the new academic year AY2023/24, we will continue this momentum by introducing further administrative and technological improvements that enhance our students' learning experience.



Enhancements to our Postgraduate Programmes

BGST aspires to equip our students to become effective ambassadors for Christ in the marketplace. To this end, we have always strived to provide flexible modes of learning that allow our students to balance their commitments between family, work and ministry. The school has also regularly offered marketplace oriented courses to help students apply their faith in their manifold contexts and challenges.

We decided to undertake a thorough revision of our academic programmes in AY2022/23 to create a deeper and wider impact to and for our students.



TWO KEY DEVELOPMENTS HAVE BEEN INTRODUCED IN AY2023/24

I. Integrative Theology Through Marketplace Ministry and Integrative Studies Pathways

The first is the launch of the marketplace ministry and integrative studies learning pathways from Graduate Diplomas to Master's Degree. Students will be progressively guided on how to discern God's guidance in their personal lives, workplaces and industries, while integrating God's Word into their everyday lives, cultural contexts, and communities.

This approach to curriculum design is incorporated and embedded in every BGST course.






II. Practical Ministry Skills Formation

The second is the introduction of practical ministry skills requirements in our programmes. In a world that increasingly questions the relevance of Christianity, we need to focus and equip beyond just theological and theoretical knowledge, but also include a broader range of ministry skills such as teaching and learning, coaching, counselling, spiritual care, change management, and leadership.



AY2022/3 also saw BGST re-accredited for our **Graduate Diploma in Christian Studies, Masters of Arts in Theology and Integrative Studies,** and **Master of Divinity** programmes with the Asia Theological Association. As the school develops a more integrative and practical approach to theological education, the elements mentioned above will become even more crucial if we are to address robustly the manifold complexities of our workplaces, churches, and communities.



Dr Quek is the Founding Principal of BGST. He has been active in the International Council of Christian Churches, missionary work worldwide and prison ministry.




Dr Jeremy Gwee

ATTENDANCE AT COUNCIL MEETINGS


There were 4 Council Meetings held between July 2022 - June 2023. Attendance by Council Members is as follows.


Dr Philip Satterthwaite

DEDICATION SERVICE


